Hester Pharmaceuticals Limited has entered into a strategic alliance with Ghen Corporation (Japan) and its subsidiary Maine Biological Laboratories (U.S.) on the state-of-the-art poultry vaccine manufacturing facilities in the country, at a cost of Rs 5 crores.

The company will also shortly introduce a range of immunocomb kits for the diagnosis of poultry, canine, feline, bovine and ovine diseases. The plant is to be based in Ahmedabad. The project, with an installed capacity of 395 million doses of live and killed vaccines, will be eligible for a subsidy of Rs 15 lakhs, being in a notified backward area. The company will use world acclaimed technology of MBN and Ghen Corporation and will also have access to all future developments at MBL and Ghen Corporation.
